2025 Grant Application Guidelines

ARTA currently awards grants in two categories Please make sure you are applying in the correct category before you begin.

Parsons-Burnett Grant - Certified Employees

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applicant must be currently employed in a certified position in an Arkansas public school.
- 2. Applicant must be working toward a specific graduate degree, endorsement or certification (excluding National Board Certification). *Requests* for funds to pay off student loans are not eligible.
- 3. Previous applicants may reapply.

Application Contents – ALL ARE REQUIRED

Personal Information

Education Plan (institution you plan to attend AND degree or certification you are pursuing)

Employment Information, including references

Personal Statement (rationale for application)

Financial Statement (rationale for application)

Innovation/Technique (description/example)

Additional volunteer/community service

Copies of Arkansas teaching license and all official graduate and undergraduate transcripts

Degree Plan (list of at least 12 semester hours of graduate education courses to be completed within a 15-month period, or equivalent for endorsement/certification sought)

Letter of reference from most recent principal/

supervisor on school letterhead

Mitchell-Fair Grant - Classified Employees

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicant must be currently employed in a classified position in an Arkansas public school AND have at least three (3) years of service credit in the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System.
- 2. Applicant must have at least 60 credit hours in an accredited college.
- 3. Applicant must be working toward an Arkansas teaching license. Requests for funds to pay off student loans are not eligible.

Application Contents – ALL ARE REQUIRED

- Personal Information
 Education Plan (institution you plan to attend
 AND description of degree you are pursuing)
 Employment Information, including references
 Personal Statement (rationale for application)
 Financial Statement (rationale for application)
 Additional school/community involvement
 Copies of official and academic transcripts
 Degree Plan (acceptance letter/proof of enrollment list of courses for which you are registered, etc.)
 Letter of reference from most recent principal/
 supervisor on school letterhead
- Narrative/descriptive portions of the application may be cut and pasted from a text document.
- Supporting documents should be uploaded within the application.
- You will be able to save your application and return to it later.
- Applications must be completed ONLINE by March 31, 2025.
- INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE SCORED.
